“Family Law Updates—2019: Recent statutes, revised court forms, & Supreme Court opinions”

Additionally, presenter will summarize recent Supreme Court opinions, with a focus on parenting cases. Attendees will be asked to share how recent legal changes, including the federal tax law, alimony reform, and revisions to parenting law and plan.

Also, will consider what parenting provisions would work when DV, addiction, long travel distance or other special factors are present.
